## FOR ACTION

1. <u>BILL 87 (2020)</u> – **PUBLIC TRANSIT.** Amending Chapter 13, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, to amend the fare for paratransit services. (Bill passed second reading and public hearing held 12/9/20; Committee postponed action 2/3/21)

PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 87 (2020) (Submitted by Councilmember Say) – The CD1 (OCS2021-0351/4/14/2021 1:32 PM) makes the following amendments:

- A. Amends SECTION 2 of the bill as follows:
  - 1. Sets forth ROH Section 13-4.5 in its entirety (as opposed to just subsection (b) of that section) and updates the amendatory language to reflect amendments made to ROH Section 13-4.5 by Ordinance 20-19 (currently uncodified);
  - 2. Amends ROH Section 13-4.5(d) by replacing all provisions relating to the paratransit eligible individual bus pass with provisions relating to the programmed city payment card, which will be issued to paratransit eligibility ID holders for the reduced fare on the city bus system and city rail system for paratransit eligibility ID holders as specified in the Fare Structure Table in ROH Section 13-2.1; and
  - 3. Deletes ROH Section 13-4.5(e) and (g) and redesignates ROH Section 13-4.5(f) as ROH Section 13-4.5(e).
- B. Deletes SECTION 3 of the bill and renumbers subsequent SECTIONS of the bill.
- C. Amends renumbered SECTION 3 (Revisor of Ordinances section) to specify that in SECTION 2 of the bill, the Revisor of Ordinances shall insert the appropriate section number for the reference to ROH Section 2-12.\_\_\_\_\_ from SECTION 2 of Ordinance 21-7 upon its codification.
- D. Amends renumbered SECTION 4 (Effective date section) to specify that the increase in fare from \$2.00 to \$2.25 for persons with paratransit eligibility ID cards, as specified in ROH Section 13-4.5(b), as amended in SECTION 2 of the bill, takes effect on July 1, 2022.
- E. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.
