Your Committee on Zoning and Planning, which considered Resolution 21-126 entitled:

"RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF
MR. PANE MEATOGA III TO SERVE ON THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF
THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU,"

introduced on May 20, 2021, reports as follows:

The purpose of Resolution 21-126 is to confirm the appointment of Pane Meatoga III to serve on the Planning Commission of the City and County of Honolulu. By Mayor's Message 81 (2021), the Mayor has requested Council confirmation of Mr. Meatoga's appointment, for a term to expire on June 30, 2022.

A public hearing on Mr. Meatoga's appointment was held on June 2, 2021.

At your Committee's meeting on June 17, 2021, Mr. Meatoga provided information on his background, expressed his willingness to serve on the Planning Commission, and responded to questions from Councilmembers.

The Director of Planning and Permitting testified in support of the Resolution.
