VIEWING THE MEETING AND RESTRICTIONS ON ENTRY

ORAL TESTIMONY

Oral testimony will be permitted on all items on the agenda, subject to the following restrictions:

Registrants will receive an email that contains links and information on joining the meeting by either phone or video conference. Webex testifiers are strongly encouraged to register at least 24 hours before the start of the meeting. Remote testimony will be taken at the start of the agenda and then closed.
2. Each speaker is limited to one-minute presentation.

- A. Adds a new SECTION 3 defining "pass-through" rather than "pass through," to conform to the use of "pass-through" (with a hyphen) throughout the article. Renumbers subsequent SECTIONS accordingly.
- B. Makes miscellaneous and technical nonsubstantive amendments, including amendments to comport the bill with recommended drafting style.
