I live at Iroquois Point.

North Road is the only access road. Formation of this task force promises to finally address the needs of the residents who must use North Road.

We need lighting on North Road for security. We need sidewalks and a bike lane so that students and residents can use the road safely. The road goes directly to Campbell High School from Iroquois. Yet, many parents refuse to let their children bike on the road, even during broad daylight, because of safety and security fears.

It is the only route from the nearest public transportation stop to Iroquois, approximately one mile away.

Written Testimony We need security cameras or another method so that illegal dumping can be addressed and reduced, if not eliminated, once and for all.

The city will not pick up the trash on this section of the road. Neither will it pick up abandoned vehicles. Local residents have diligently and faithfully cleaned up the road on their own time, using their own money, usually to see the area trashed again within days, if not hours.

Since the decision was made that Ewa would become the development site for Oahu so that other communities could stay less developed, it is only fair that Ewa be maintained as a developed site should be - lights on roadways, safety for school children on bikes, and residents who have to walk to and from the bus stop NOT having to walk around piles and piles of trash and garbage in the weeds and road.

This road to the home of approximately 5,000 people at Iroquois should be treated with the

dignity and respect residents deserve as taxpayers.

This road has a long history of being taken advantage of as a secluded and hidden part of the local region.

Those days are gone.

This area could be re-vitalized into a beautiful and unique spot and creation of this task force is a welcome first step.
