Your Committee on Transportation, Sustainability and Health, which considered Resolution 21-193 entitled:

"RESOLUTION URGING THE GOVERNOR TO REINSTATE PRE-TRAVEL COVID-19 TESTING FOR DOMESTIC AND INTERNATIONAL TRAVELERS TO HAWAII REGARDLESS OF THEIR VACCINATION STATUS,"

introduced on August 27, 2021, reports as follows:

The purpose of the Resolution is to urge the Governor to reinstate pre-travel COVID-19 testing for domestic and international travelers to Hawai'i, regardless of their vaccination status.

At your Committee meeting on September 2, 2021, five individuals testified remotely in support of, and 22 testified in opposition to, the Resolution.

Your Committee received 25 written testimonies in support of, and 22 in opposition to, the Resolution.

Your Committee also received written testimony in support of the Resolution from Aloha Care and the Hawai'i Lodging & Tourism Association.


