"RESOLUTION URGING THE GOVERNOR TO REINSTATE PRE-TRAVEL COVID-19 TESTING FOR DOMESTIC AND INTERNATIONAL TRAVELERS TO HAWAI'I REGARDLESS OF THEIR VACCINATION STATUS,"

introduced on August 27, 2021, reports as follows:

The purpose of the Resolution is to urge the Governor to reinstate pre-travel COVID-19 testing for domestic and international travelers to Hawai'i, regardless of their vaccination status.

Your Committee received 25 written testimonies in support of, and 22 in opposition to, the Resolution.
