I frequently call HPD and PUC to report illegal commercial activity in Hunananiho. It is mostly weddings. Now it is like Vegas there, couples literally lining up to get married. Vendors stay there and have revolving weddings. They are unmasked, not following social distance. and sometimes exceed the covid gathering restrictions. Weddings also happen illegally on the weekends, in the park, and also by the back gate of Hunananiho - Aloiloi Street residential. It is not only weddings, I've reported tour companies, exceeding the recreational stop, and being there for hours. There's also commercial picnics, and photography for advertisement. Vendors are getting aggressive, confrontational and keep on breaking the laws. HPD is not able to enforce if it is a DLNR permit. Vendors are supposed to have paper permits on hand, and they don't. Furthermore, there is a proplem with DLNR issuing permits on city jurisdiction. Hunananiho is the only place commercial activity is allowed from Makapu'u to Mokapu. Sherwood's is the most sacred area, with bones dating back to 800ad. This special place is a funerary, and needs to be respected. The laws should be consistent across our coasts of Waimanalo and Kailua. Our community has fought long and hard to keep the country country. You can't put a price on paradise, it needs to be left alone. I hope the

Dear City Council Chair and Councilmembers,

I'm writing on behalf of the Oahu Wedding Association regarding Bill 38. As this Bill is currently written, we strongly oppose the bill. It is our understanding that there are two key issues and points of conflict with regards to beach weddings at City and County Parks and DLNR shorelines on the windward side of Oahu. First, there is widespread confusion and sometimes contradictory rules in place in the permitting

process for beach parks who share the same or overlapping

Written Testimony jurisdiction. This has led to general misunderstanding between the State, City, law enforcement, community and wedding industry as to what is and what is not permissible. If the intent of this bill is to weed out bad actors in the community, unfortunately this bill will not address these ongoing concerns. Secondly, and in concert with the first, there is a general lack of communication and understanding between all stakeholders as to enforcement of the permits. For this bill to move forward, we recommend a collaborative meeting with the leaders from CC Parks and Rec, DLNR, HPD, DOCARE, community members, and industry members to identify a path forward where rules are clearly

and uniformly defined and enforceable.

I took five years of 'olelo Hawai'i, have danced hula for 41 years, competed in Merrie Monarch three years. raised all three of my keiki (ages 16, 14 and 11) in Keiki O Ka 'Aina programs and have volunteered with various native Hawaiian organizations. We paddled for Kailua Canoe Club where my 80-yearold mother served on the board. I surf every day, as the ocean and beaches are my sanctuary.

Written **Testimony**  I perform native Hawaiian-based wedding and vow renewal ceremonies every day on our shores, including Waimānalo. I take my job very seriously, and incorporate numerous Hawaiian elements into the ceremony; I chant, pule, incorporate an intimate message of aloha, talk about the significance of lei exchange and initiate the honihoni. It is vital that my couples walk away from their marriage ceremony understanding that Hawaii is a very special and spiritual place for their union to take place. I want them to feel embraced by our spirit, and gain knowledge of our culture through the 17 minutes I have with them.

I care for our shores just as a care for my home. Our local wedding industry strives each day to "leave no trace / footprint." In a time when there is so much divisiveness, fighting and division politically and as a result of the pandemic in our world, I am committed to standing up and fighting for our right to perform ceremonies on our shores. We are creating new beginnings, new families, new unions, love, aloha and

togetherness.

All who are involved in Beach Park commercial business need to understand – and affirm by their own personal accountability - the principles that underlie the banning of commercial activity on our beaches and ROWs. The banning is rooted in the fundamental principle of Public Lands, codification of which has been increasingly

more clear over the last 100 years.

The Beach Parks in Bill 38 are Public Lands, declared such by past Hawaii Governors' Executive Orders. Ex Ord #115, for example,

created Kailua Beach Park. Waimanalo Beach Park legal partition followed shortly in early 1920's. Our Beach Parks are based on the fundamental law of Public Lands serving the Public. In receiving these Territorial lands, the City took on the obligation to protect and police

as Public Lands.

Public Lands means: Not Private Lands. Public Lands benefit the Public writ large. Not for the benefit of adjacent Private Property owners. Not for the benefit of any Private interests. Private

Companies are prohibited from conducting business on Public Land. The fundamental underlying principle is unwavering: Public Lands were created to serve the Public. The Beach Parks and ROWS in Bill 38 are Public Lands and must be respected as such by all of us, by our instinct, by our conduct. End of issue

our instinct, by our conduct. End of issue.

The jurisdictional, geographical, and kuleana boundary complexities of State and City Government hobbles the discovery, the policing, the

1

Written Testimony enforcement, and prevention of willful Private Use of Public Lands. This encorages the Commercial Exploitation we see today. The Executive Orders that created our Public Lands also state that failure of the City to retain as Public Lands will result in return of these Lands to the Territorial (State) Government. Territorial Government was thus acutely aware of potential for Private Exploitation of its outplaced Public Land, proven by its proviso of a draconian deterrent. To their great credit our predecessors gave us Public Lands. They instructed us sternly in their preservation. We have the obligation to reaffirm the concept of Public Land for Public Benefit and get it right, as intended.

Imagine if the Beach Parks had a voice and could stand up for themselves. The Whanganui River Watershed in New Zealand has the legal stature of a Person for the purpose of eliminating exploitation. What if Hawaii's Public Lands had rights? We have the senior, the sincere, and the personal obligation to behave as if our Public lands did have rights. Let's be diligent and responsible. Let's enact legislation to defend Public Lands accordingly. Thank you for this opportunity to testify in favor of Bill 38.

#### Written Testimony in Support of Bill 38 Submitted by Sarah Gilman Sur, 12A Kailua Road

Aloha. I am her to testify in support of Bill 38. I am not a Waimanalo resident, but am a resident of Kailua and am here to support the community of Waimanalo. My family has resided on our property here on Kailua Beach since the 1930's, We see first-hand the illegal commercial activity taking place.

Commercialization, in general, of our beaches and public parks prior to the pandemic and during the pandemic is increasingly taking a toll--not only on local residents, but on our natural resources. Commercial operators demonstrate zero respect for such resources and instead choose to exploit them for their bottom line, Despite commercial activity being banned in 2012 for Kailua Beach and Kailua Beach Park, we continue to see illegal commercial activity on a daily basis. There is a lack of enforcement here in Kailua. In supporting Bill 38, I urge all of you, City Council, to work with HPD and DLNR to ensure that this bill--if passed--is enforced.

I would like to remind the Council of a 2019 report entitled *Socioeconomic impacts of tourism in Kailua and Waimanalo, Hawai'i* (<a href="https://seagrant.soest.hawaii.edu/wp-content/uploads/2020/12/SocioEcon-FINAL-report.pdf">https://seagrant.soest.hawaii.edu/wp-content/uploads/2020/12/SocioEcon-FINAL-report.pdf</a>). Funding for this project was provided by the City and County of Honolulu and the Office of Climate Change, Sustainability and Resiliency. The study itself was designed to determine the social, economic, and natural resource visitor impacts on Windward Oʻahu. The report surveyed both Kailua and Waimanalo residents, as well as visitors to Kailua and Waimanalo.

The results revealed widespread concern about tourism among the residents of both communities. In the case of each resident survey, over 65% of respondents agreed or strongly agreed that:

- "tourism has increased traffic."
- "tourism has increased the cost of living,"
- "tourism has destroyed the small town feel" of the city
- "vacation rentals have reduced the availability of housing for locals,"
- "tourism has made transportation more difficult for locals."
- "government decisions on tourism issues tend to favor tourists over locals."

This report does recommend the consideration of the following top priorities:

- "negative effects of tourism on the overall quality of life"
- "effective leadership to solve problems caused by tourism"

It is my hope that City Council will utilize its effective leadership to help our community solve these problems of commercialization/tourism. Supporting Bill 38 is one such way of demonstrating this body's effective leadership.
