FOR ACTION

1. <u>BILL 48 (2021)</u> – **UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS.** Relating to underground storage tanks. (Bill passed first reading on 12/15/21)

PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 48 (2021) (Submitted by Councilmember Cordero) – The CD1 (OCS2022-0007/1/5/2022 8:01 AM) makes the following amendments:

- A. In SECTION 2 of the bill, the CD1:
 - Adds a new Section 41-45.1 ("Definitions") amplifying former Section 4145.1(a) and adding specific definitions for "Department" and "Department of Health."
 - 2. Provides that the new Article 45 in ROH Chapter 41 relating to underground storage tanks ("USTs") will be implemented and enforced by the department or agency designated by the Mayor.
 - 3. Provides that the standard for granting or renewal of a UST permit will be whether the UST or UST system will be protective of human health and the environment, rather than a determination that the UST or UST system will not leak any regulated substance into the environment during its operating life.
 - 4. Adds new ROH Sections 41-45.3 ("Underground storage tank permit procedures"), 41-45.4 ("Inspections"), 41-45.5 ("Notification and reporting"), and 41-45.6 ("Administration and enforcement").
 - 5. The rulemaking provision has been moved from Section 41-45.1(d) to Section 41-45.6(d).
