

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED COMMITTEE DRAFT:

**RESOLUTION 22-8
CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF CHRISTOPHER T. HONG TO SERVE ON
THE BUILDING BOARD OF APPEALS OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
HONOLULU.**

The PROPOSED CD1 makes the following amendments:

- A. Moves the fifth WHEREAS clause, regarding engineer and architect license qualifications for four members of the Building Board of Appeals, to be the third WHEREAS clause.
- B. Throughout the resolution, updates the references to the ROH provision establishing the Building Board of Appeals, its membership, and duties (currently ROH Section 16-1.1 (14)).
- C. In Item (1) of the second WHEREAS clause, clarifies that the Building Board of Appeals also hears and determines appeals of decisions regarding the administration of the Energy Code.
- D. In the renumbered fourth WHEREAS clause, adds a reference to Mayor's Message 6 (2022), dated January 10, 2022.
- E. Adds the Director of Planning and Permitting as a recipient of a copy of the resolution.
- F. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.



RESOLUTION

CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF CHRISTOPHER T. HONG TO SERVE ON THE BUILDING BOARD OF APPEALS OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

WHEREAS, Section 16-1.1(14), Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990 ("ROH"), establishes the Building Board of Appeals consisting of nine members who are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu ("Council") to five-year terms; and

WHEREAS, ROH Section 16-1.1(14) provides that the Building Board of Appeals has the duties of hearing and determining the following:

- (1) Appeals of decisions regarding the administration of the Building Code, Electrical Code, Plumbing Code, Housing Code, Fire Code, Energy Code, Building Energy Efficiency Standards, and the building permit ordinance;
- (2) Petitions for variances from the Building Code, Electrical Code, Plumbing Code, Fire Code, and Building Energy Efficiency Standards;
- (3) Appeals of decisions regarding the administrative enforcement of the litter control ordinance; and
- (4) Appeals concerning the summary removal of unlawful signs from street rights-of-way and public malls; and

WHEREAS, ROH Section 16-1.1(14) establishes a general qualification requiring four members of the Building Board of Appeals to be "currently licensed as engineers or architects with the State of Hawaii board of registration of professional engineers, architects, land surveyors, and landscape architects"; and

WHEREAS, by Mayor's Message 6 (2022), dated January 10, 2022, the Mayor has reappointed Mr. Christopher T. Hong to the Building Board of Appeals; and

WHEREAS, if confirmed by the Council, Mr. Christopher T. Hong will be reappointed as an Engineer/Architect member on the Building Board of Appeals and serve for a term to expire on December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Section 13-103, Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu 1973 (Amended 2017 Edition), as amended, which applies to the Building Board of Appeals, requires a member to be a registered voter of the City and County of Honolulu ("City"); and
