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## Honolulu Emergency Services Department Budget Highlights for FY 2023

Proposed FY23 budget reflects a decrease of 5.9 % from the current fiscal year

- Administration = 271% increase
  - EMS = 20.6% decrease
- **→** Health Services = 12.3% increase
  - Ocean Safety = 13.6% increase

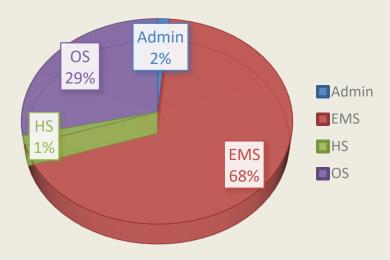




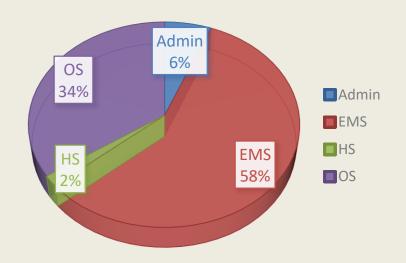

#### **FY 2023 Capital Budget and Program Summary**



- Red 4-WD Trucks: Quantity 4 X \$55,000 each = \$220,000 (OSD)
- Mobile Office Containers: Quantity 2 X \$50,000 each = \$100,000 (OSD)
- Ambulances: Quantity 4 X \$300,000 each = \$1,200,000 (EMS)
- Fork Lift: Quantity 1 X \$37,000 = \$37,000 (EMS)
- Delivery Van: Quantity 1 X \$50,000 = \$50,000 (EMS)
