As the budget committee initiates its review process of Councilmember's proposed amendments to the FY23 Executive Operating and Capital Budgets, I provide the following explanation for the proposed amendment to Bill 15 (2022) to reduce funding for Project No. 2012077 - Civic Center Parking Structure – Reconstruction.

The proposed reduction of \$10,000,000 in funds appropriated for Construction for Civic Center Parking Structure – Reconstruction as the City Council is based upon a lack of overview of the improvements proposed in the FY23 CIP budget.

It is also unclear from Department Communication No. 91 (D-91) – Department of Design and Construction's Quarterly Status Report for FY2022 Second Quarter ending December 31, 2021 - Project No. 12077 – Civic Center Parking Structure-Waterproofing & Reconstruction (Page 32) why there is a need for additional \$20,700,000 (\$10,000 - Design, \$20,000,000 - Construction, 690,000 - Inspection) in funds. D-91 identifies FY22 allocation of \$175,000 (\$50,000 - Design, \$175,000 - Construction) is and states that the Civic Center Parking Structure Improvements approximate bid date will be 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2023, with an estimated construction start in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2024.

The proposal to phase-in the construction cost by allocating \$10,000,000 in FY23 and a subsequent proposal for the remaining \$10,000,000 by the City Administration in FY24 seems more appropriate in meeting the anticipated deadlines identified in D-91, particularly in the face of global construction supply line shortages.

I look forward to having further discussions on the timing of appropriation funds for the project at the special Budget Committee Meeting on March 30, 2022.

The Executive Capital Program for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, is incorporated by reference and made a part of this ordinance in the form of narrative descriptions of each capital project in Sections 2 through 8 herein. Such Program is hereby adopted as required by the Charter. In case of any conflict between the substantive provisions of the Executive Capital Program and the Executive Program and Budget for the Fiscal Year 2023, Volume 2 (Capital Program and Budget), as transmitted to the Council, and this ordinance, the provisions of this ordinance and the amendments thereto shall prevail, and the specific provisos contained in the narrative descriptions of each capital project shall have the same force and effect as the general provisos contained in this portion of the ordinance.

[The project number is] In this ordinance, project numbers are included for accounting purposes only. If there is a conflict between the number and the project title in this ordinance, the project title shall prevail. In Sections 2 through 8 of this ordinance, if there is a conflict between the work phases set forth in the narrative description of a project and the work phases set forth in the work phase column for the project, the work phases as set forth in the work phase column shall prevail.

SECTION 16. The Executive Operating Program for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, as transmitted to the Council in the Executive Program and Budget for the Fiscal Year 2023, Volume I (Operating Program and Budget), and as amended in any Executive Operating Program amendments, is hereby incorporated by reference and adopted as an integral part of this ordinance. The detailed Statement of Revenues and Surplus contained therein may be further amended regarding any applicable fund by any amendment to the Executive Operating Budget ordinance, Executive Capital Budget ordinance, Legislative Budget ordinance, Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation Operating Budget ordinance, or Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation Capital Budget ordinance. In case of any conflict between the substantive provisions of the Executive Operating Program, as transmitted to the Council, and this ordinance or the above budget amendments, the provisions of this ordinance and any of the above budget amendments shall prevail.

SECTION 17. References to any ROH section in this ordinance include a reference to that section as it may be amended or to any successor section in a recodification of the ROH.

- (g) The project number is included for accounting purposes only. If there is a conflict between the number and the project title in this ordinance, the project title shall prevail.
- (h) In Section 2 of this ordinance, if there is a conflict between the work phases set forth in the narrative description of a project and the work phases set forth in the work phase column for the project, the work phases set forth in the work phase column shall prevail.
