A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

RELATING TO LOBBYIST NOTARY REQUIREMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to remove the notary requirement for lobbyist filings with the Honolulu Ethics Commission.

SECTION 2. Section 3-13.4, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, is amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 3-13.4 [Registration] <u>Certification of registration</u> and report forms [toconform to law and truth].

Each registration and report form required to be filed under this article [shallconform to law and truth and] shall be [signed and] certified [under oath as true andcorrect] by the registrant [, or, if the registrant is a person other than an individual, by an appropriate officer of such registrant]."

SECTION 3. Ordinance material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New material is underscored. When revising, compiling, or printing this ordinance for inclusion in the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu, the Revisor of Ordinances need not include the brackets, the material that has been bracketed and stricken or the underscoring.
