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## RESOLUTION

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REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES TO DEVELOP A LANIKAI TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, world-famous Lanikai Beach is a popular beach on the windward side of O'ahu that attracts thousands of visitors and Hawai'i residents each day; and

WHEREAS, the shoreline of Lanikai Beach runs parallel with Mokulua Drive, which passes through the residential neighborhood of Lanikai; and

WHEREAS, the Lanikai neighborhood is accessed primarily by a one-way traffic loop consisting of 'A'alapapa Drive entering the neighborhood and Mokulua Drive exiting the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, Lanikai Beach does not have a public park fronting the beach or a single entrance point, but, instead, has several public beach access paths that run between privately-owned properties on the makai side of Mokulua Drive; and

WHEREAS, Lanikai Beach offers no designated public parking, bathroom facilities, or concessions, and many beach users seek parking in the Lanikai neighborhood, sometimes far from the beach; and

WHEREAS, the Lanikai neighborhood has no improved sidewalks, many narrow one-way streets, and only limited on-street parking, which is subject to restrictions under the Statewide Traffic Code (Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes) and the Traffic Code of the City and County of Honolulu (Chapter 15, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990); and

WHEREAS, due to these restrictions, parking is prohibited in the following locations in Lanikai: on the unimproved shoulders and bike lane throughout the entirety of 'A'alapapa and Mokulua Drives, in designated areas of the one-way cross streets connecting 'A'alapapa and Mokulua Drives and other non-through Lanikai roadways; within four feet of a driveway; within 30 feet approaching a stop sign; within 10 feet of a fire hydrant; and on unimproved sidewalks, among other places; and

WHEREAS, the increasing demand for Lanikai Beach parking often results in severe traffic congestion, illegal parking on unimproved shoulders and in front of (and blocking) private driveways, unsafe conditions for pedestrians, bicyclists, and residents, and the obstruction of emergency response vehicles; and



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WHEREAS, special access and parking rules have been implemented with some success for Lanikai during holiday weekends and certain City projects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council ("Council") finds that there is a compelling need to find and implement solutions to address these issues, which have a severe impact on the quality of life for Lanikai residents and communities engaged in canoe-paddling and other ocean-related activities, and that an assessment of parking options and a Lanikai transportation management plan would assist the City and the community in determining the most appropriate measures to be taken to address these issues; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that the Director of Transportation Services is requested to develop, and provide the Council with, a Lanikai transportation management plan to relieve traffic congestion in Lanikai, improve access to first responders and overall roadway safety, provide ease of access to Lanikai Beach, and provide reasonable and appropriate parking controls for Lanikai residents and Lanikai Beach users; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the plan should include an assessment that evaluates the feasibility of potential options, including, but not limited to, additional parking restrictions, off-street and off-site parking solutions, improved transit options, and improved multi-modal access opportunities; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director is requested to provide the transportation management plan in writing to the Council no later than 90 days following the adoption of this resolution; and


