Your Committee on Transportation, Sustainability and Health which considered Resolution 22-125 entitled:

"RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES TO DEVELOP A LANIKAI TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT PLAN,"

introduced on May 18, 2022, reports as follows:

The purpose of the Resolution is to request the Director of Transportation Services to develop, and provide the Council with, a Lanikai transportation management plan to relieve traffic congestion in Lanikai, improve access to first responders and overall roadway safety, provide ease of access to Lanikai Beach, and provide reasonable and appropriate parking controls for Lanikai residents and Lanikai beach users.

The Director of the Department of Transportation Services testified in support of the Resolution.

At your Committee meeting on June 14, 2022, five individuals remotely testified in support, an individual provided comments, and two individuals testified in-person in support of the Resolution.

Your Committee received written testimony from 21 individuals in support and 14 individuals provided comments on the Resolution.


