

# Better Building Benchmarking Program

Committee on Transportation, Sustainability & Health June 14, 2022





### **Proposed Amendments**

- Extend the timeline for initial reporting to June 30, 2023, and extend timeline for phases II and III to June 2024 and 2025 respectively, to ensure utilities, property owners, and key stakeholders are prepared for implementation (*Sec. 1.3 Benchmarking Schedule*)
- Clarify what data the City will disclose and disclosure process to enable additional review by and time for property owners (*Sec. 1.6 Publication of Data*)
- Clarify building owner/lessee shall report rather than landowner and add other requested definitions for further clarity



### **Proposed Amendments**

- Revise penalties and establish an annual cap on fines to ensure property owners are not unreasonably burdened in instances of noncompliance (Sec. 1.5 Penalty for Violations and Enforcement)
- Provide flexibility where aggregated-whole building data cannot be obtained from a utility through additional exemption or extension options (Sec. 1.4 Exemptions & Time Extensions)
