Subject: Council Bill 22, CD1: Relating to Building Benchmarking

The Honolulu Board of Water Supply (BWS) strongly supports Bill 22, CD1, relating to building benchmarking, which requires the measuring and reporting of a building's energy and water usage trends as a conservation metric to incentivize reduction. By establishing a baseline, water consumers will be better able to measure their water usage. Reducing energy and water usage not only meets sustainability goals and preserves natural resources, it reduces consumer utility bills.

With the reduction in 3 major water sources serving Aiea to Hawaii Kai due to the Red Hill fuel contamination, and the current drought, the BWS is asking island residents and businesses to voluntarily reduce their water use by 10 percent, to prepare for the summer season and prevent more restrictive conservation measures, if necessary.
