## RESOLUTION

AFFIRMING THE OFFICIAL PLACE NAME OF KÜʻĪLIOLOA HEIAU, LOCATED WITHIN PŌKAʻĪ BAY BEACH PARK IN WAIʻANAE AND REQUESTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION TO OFFICIALLY DESIGNATE THE NAME AND INSTALL APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE.

WHEREAS, Section 22-9.3(a)(2), Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990 ("ROH"), provides that a new or existing park, site, or facility may be named:

- 1. For the neighborhood, community, district, or region in which the park, site, or facility is located;
- 2. After the primary street which it abuts; or
- 3. In the Hawaiian language with a name which describes the site or its use, function or purpose; and

WHEREAS, ROH Section 22-9.4(b) states that permanent statues, busts, or other memorials may be erected, placed, or installed in city parks, sites, and facilities to honor:

- (1) Persons or groups that have a significant association with the park, site, or facility;
- (2) Persons or groups for which a park, site, or facility has been named;
- (3) A belief, ideal, concept, or historical event of significance to the community, city, state, nation, or world:
- (4) A historical event of significance to the park, site, or facility;
- (5) A person or group which has contributed significantly to the park, site, or facility;
- (6) A person or group which has achieved significant recognition historically on the city, state, national, or international level; or
- (7) A person or group which has been honored for service with the armed forces of the United States of America; and



## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, ROH Section 22-9.5(f) authorizes the City Council ("Council") to "on its own motion, designate a name for a new or existing park, site, facility, or any portion thereof, or memorial, consistent with the requirements set forth herein, by adoption of an appropriate resolution"; and

WHEREAS, Pōka'ī Bay Beach Park is a 15.49-acre City and County of Honolulu park that is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Parks and Recreation and located at 85-037 Wai'anae Valley Road; and

WHEREAS, a heiau known as Kūʻīlioloa, named in honor of the demigod who protected travelers, is located on Pōkaʻī Bay Beach Park's Kāneʻīlio Point; and

WHEREAS, the Wai'anae coast served as a refuge for the original O'ahu aristocracy after the invasion of the Kingdom of O'ahu by Kamehameha the Great in 1795; and

WHEREAS, historical articles indicate that Kūʻīlioloa Heiau was used as a school for the youth of Waiʻanae by the defeated Oʻahu kahuna to teach history, astronomy, navigation, and genealogies of ancient chiefs and kings; and

WHEREAS, it is thought that Kamehameha I may have visited Kūʻīlioloa Heiau during the time he spent in Waiʻanae after the Battle of Nuʻuanu; and

WHEREAS, Ali'i Sir Shad Kane, Ali'i 'Ai Moku of the Royal Order of Kamehameha I, has recommended that an identifying plaque with the name "Kū'īlioloa" accompany the heiau at Pōka'ī Bay; and

WHEREAS, the Council supports installing identifying signage at Kūʻīlioloa Heiau in order to preserve the name of this historical and cultural landmark and to educate the public in the history and culture of Oʻahu and the Kingdom of Hawaiʻi; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that it affirms the official place name of Kūʻīlioloa Heiau, located within Pōkaʻī Bay Beach Park, Waiʻanae; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council requests the City Administration to install appropriate signage designating Kūʻīlioloa Heiau and approves the placement of such signage at Pōkaʻī Bay Beach Park, including historical markers; and
