RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 13-103 of the Charter requires a Commission member to be a registered voter of the City; and

WHEREAS, by Mayor's letter, dated August 18, 2022, the Mayor has reappointed Mr. Grant Kagimoto to the Grants in Aid Advisory Commission; and

WHEREADS, if confirmed by the Council, Mr. Kagimoto will serve for a term to expire on January 14, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed Mr. Kagimoto's qualifications and character and finds that he qualifies to serve on the Commission and deserves confirmation; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that this body confirms the appointment of Mr. Grant Kagimoto to the Grants in Aid Advisory Commission for a term expiring on January 14, 2027; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to Mr. Kagimoto for his willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in city government; and
