Your Committee on Parks and Community Services, which considered Resolution 22-194 entitled:

"RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION TO FORMALIZE THE CARETAKING RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FAMILY OF THE LATE CAROL AZAMA FOR THE PARK LOCATED IN THE WAI'ŌMA'O SLIDE AREA,"

introduced on August 17, 2022, reports as follows:

The purpose of Resolution 22-194 is to formalize the caretaking rights and responsibilities of the family of the late Carol Azama for the park located at TMK 3-4-030:005 in the Wai'ōma'o Slide Area.

Kehaulani Puu, Deputy Director of Parks and Recreation, testified in support of the measure and expressed gratitude for the late Carol Azama and her family on behalf of the department. Deputy Director Puu further expressed that the department is willing to work with the introducer of the measure, Councilmember Say, and the Azama family on an agreement to adopt an undeveloped park.

Your Committee received no public testimony and no written testimony on the Resolution.


