Your Committee on Public Safety which considered Resolution 22-182 entitled:

"RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF OVERT VIDEO MONITORING IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU IN CAMPBELL INDUSTRIAL PARK, TO PREVENT AND DETER GENERAL CRIMINAL ACTIVITY."

introduced on August 3, 2022 reports as follows:

The purpose of the Resolution is to authorize the use of overt video monitoring in the City and County of Honolulu in Campbell Industrial Park to prevent and deter general criminal activity.

The Acting Major for the Honolulu Police Department's ("HPD") District 8 testified in opposition of the resolution, noting that HPD does not have adequate staffing to continuously monitor this section of the district.

The Director of the Department of Information Technology provided technical comments on the resolution, which included noting that camera networking and power would represent the largest cost in this type of proposal.

At your Committee's meeting on September 19, 2022, a representative of Ho'omana Pono, LLC testified remotely in support of the Resolution.

At your Committee's meeting, one individual and three organizations submitted written testimony in support of the Resolution.
