5. Name three qualities that best describe you and that would make you stand out. How would these qualities benefit the BWS?
6. Name one previous experience that would make you stand out. How would this benefit the BWS?
7. With respect to the number of spills associated with the Red Hill Fuel Storage facility, the past 18-24 months have resulted in dramatic impacts upon Honolulu Board of Water

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Supply operations. What additional actions or steps would you like the board to take in pursuing preventative actions affecting Oahu's fresh drinking water supplies?

8. Can you foresee any potential conflicts of interest that may arise during your service?
How would you overcome any potential conflicts of interest?
