

Re: In Support of the Proposed CD2 to Bill 39 (2022), RELATING TO THE PLUMBING CODE

Aloha Chair, Vice Chair and Committee Members;

Mahalo for the opportunity to testify in support of the proposed CD2 to Bill 39 (2022), which updates the current plumbing code for the City and County of Honolulu.

Adopting the proposed CD2 to Bill 39 (2022) most importantly supports the underlying intent to safeguard public health, safety, and welfare by ensuring that plumbing systems are designed and constructed according to minimum industry standards by qualified and licensed professionals.

Specifically, the proposed CD2 restores Section 102 of the State Plumbing Code which prescribes compliance and consistency with state law within the body of the ordinance.
