3. **[BILL 52 \(2022\)](#) – RELATING TO BULLYING OF YOUTH.** Preventing the bullying of youths in City programs and on City property; to prevent retaliation against persons who report, or participate in any investigation into a suspected incident of youth bullying; and to provide for the establishment of City policies and procedures for the handling of suspected incidents of the bullying of youths in City programs and on City property.
