**"RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION TO
WORK COOPERATIVELY WITH COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDERS TO
RELOCATE CITY-OWNED SURF RACKS IN WAIKĪKĪ,"**

introduced on December 14, 2022, reports as follows:

The purpose of Resolution 22-290 is to encourage the City Administration to work cooperatively with community stakeholders to relocate City-owned surf racks in Waikīkī and explore whether the formation of a public-private partnership with proximate landowners or hotels would enhance the operation and maintenance of City-owned surf racks in Waikīkī.

Jerry Pupillo, Director of Enterprise Services, testified that the City Administration is in support of working with community stakeholders to determine the best location for the City-owned surf racks.

Your Committee received no oral or written public testimony on the Resolution.
