3	22-32	2/17/22	LUO amendment relating to the Chinatown Special District to require a Special District Permit for distribution of food free of charge on the public sidewalk.	DPP transmitted a recommendation to the Planning Commission on January 5, 2023. Planning Commission voted to recommend denial of the proposed amendment on January 25, 2023. The recommendation was sent to the City Council on February 1, 2023 [D-0083(23)].
