The onsite or off-site consumption of malt beverages, distilled spirits, or wine is determined by the type of liquor license obtained from the Honolulu liquor commission. (1) Minor: Producing a maximum of 10,000 barrels a year. [The term includes the sale of malt beverages, distilled spirits, or wine for onsite consumption.] The term includes guided tours and free tastings of malt beverages, distilled spirits, or wine produced onsite. (2) Major: Producing more than 10,000 barrels a year. The term includes guided tours and free tastings of malt beverages, distilled spirits, or wine produced onsite.
