1	<a href="#">19-305</a>	11/8/20	LUO amendment relating to wind machines. The Resolution requires that all future wind machines be located five miles from any property boundary.	The Planning Commission forwarded its recommendation to Council on 5/20/21. <a href="#">Bill 28 (2021)</a> (1.25 mile setback), <a href="#">Bill 29 (2021)</a> (1,500 foot setback), and <a href="#">Bill 30 (2021)</a> (5 mile setback) passed first reading on 6/2/21. Now incorporated into <a href="#">Bill 10 (2022)</a> (1 mile setback in CD1) and <a href="#">Bill 55 (2022)</a> (1.25 mile setback).
2	<a href="#">22-32</a>	2/17/22	LUO amendment relating to the Chinatown Special District to require a Special District Permit for distribution of food free of charge on the public sidewalk.	DPP transmitted a recommendation to the Planning Commission on January 5, 2023. Planning Commission voted to recommend denial of the proposed amendment on January 25, 2023. The recommendation was sent to the City Council on February 1, 2023 [ <a href="#">D-0083(23)</a> ].
3	<a href="#">22-254</a>	10/27/22	LUO amendment relating to overhangs (to allow overhangs in the required yard and into the right-of-way in Kaimuki).	DPP confirmed receipt and provided comments and questions on December 5, 2022 [ <a href="#">D-0817(22)</a> ].
