PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 14 (2023) (Submitted by Councilmember Weyer) – The CD1 (OCS2023-0299/4/11/2023 2:12 PM) makes the following amendments:

A. In SECTION 2(d) of the bill, removes the provision that prohibits the amount of the tax after application of the credit from being less than the minimum tax set in ROH § 8-11.1(g), and instead specifies that ROH § 8-11.1(g) does not apply to real property that has been granted the tax credit.

- B. Adds a new SECTION 2(e) to the bill, which adds definitions for certain terms used throughout the bill.
- C. In SECTION 3 of the bill, changes the effective date to clarify that the ordinance applies to the tax year July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024.
- D. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.
- RESOLUTION 23-33 REAL PROPERTY TAX RATES FOR FY 2024. Determining the respective rates at which real property in the various general classes in the City and County of Honolulu shall be taxed per \$1,000 of assessed value for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024. (Public hearing held 4/19/23)
- <u>BILL 11 (2023), CD1</u> EXECUTIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FY 2024. Approving the Executive Operating Budget and Program for the fiscal year July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024. (Bill passed second reading and public hearing held 4/19/23)
