WHEREAS, Section 13-113 of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu 1973 (Amended 2017 Edition), as amended, provides the City Council ("Council") with authority to accept gifts to the City and County of Honolulu ("City"); and

WHEREAS, Resolution 05-349, CD1, FD1, establishes a policy of the Council for the solicitation and acceptance of gifts donated to the City; and

WHEREAS, the policy allows for the acceptance of gifts by the affirmative action of the Council; and

WHEREAS, through a letter dated May 19, 2023, approved by the Managing Director, the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation has submitted a request to the Council for acceptance of a gift to the City from the Pearl City Foundation, of a moss rock pedestal with a wooden sign to read, "Breene Harimoto Manana Community Park," valued at \$13,092.00, that will be installed at the Breene Harimoto Manana Community Park; and

WHEREAS, the description and value of the gift are set forth in the Declaration of Gift form attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that this body gratefully accepts the gift valued at \$13,092.00 from the Pearl City Foundation that is more fully described in the above-mentioned letter dated May 19, 2023 and the Declaration of Gift form attached hereto as Exhibit A; and
