A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 4, REVISED ORDINANCES OF HONOLULU 2021, RELATING TO FEES FOR USE OF MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this bill is to amend the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021 relating to fees for a golf identification card.

SECTION 2. Section 10-4.8, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021, is amended to read as follows:

"§ 10-4.8 Golf identification card.

- (a) To qualify for the rates expressly provided in § 10-4.2 for persons with golf identification cards, each person must present the person's golf identification card at the time of payment of golf fees.
- (b) Verification of Hawaii residency, age, and identity through provision of appropriate documents ~~[shall be]~~ is required in order for a person to qualify for a golf identification card.
- (c) A \$5 fee will be assessed for the initial golf identification card.

~~[(c)](d)~~ A \$5 \$10 fee ~~[shall]~~ will be assessed for replacement of a golf identification card."

SECTION 3. Section 10-4.9, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021, is amended to read as follows:

"§ 10-4.9 Surcharge for use of qualifying documents.

Persons who present a qualifying document at the time of payment of golf fees instead of a golf identification card shall be charged green fees applicable to persons with golf identification cards in § 10-4.2 plus ~~[a \$4]~~ an \$8 surcharge."

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 2, REVISED ORDINANCES OF HONOLULU 2021, RELATING TO ADMISSION FEES FOR THE HONOLULU ZOO.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021 relating to resident admission fees for the Honolulu Zoo.

SECTION 2. Section 10-2.1, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021, is amended to read as follows:

"§ 10-2.1 Admission fees for the Honolulu Zoo.

- (a) The following daily admission fees will be assessed for the Honolulu Zoo:
 - (1) Children two years of age and under: free. Children must be accompanied by a person 18 years of age or older;
 - (2) Resident of Hawaii, three to 12 years of age: [~~\$4~~] \$6 per person;
 - (3) Resident of Hawaii, 13 years of age and older: [~~\$8~~] \$10 per person; and
 - (4) Members of the Honolulu Zoological Society: free.
- (b) The director of enterprise services may, by rules adopted in accordance with HRS Chapter 91, establish fees for admission to the Honolulu Zoo for the following:
 - (1) The United States [~~Military;~~] military;
 - (2) Nonresidents of Hawaii, three to 12 years of age; and
 - (3) Nonresidents of Hawaii, 13 years of age and older.
- (c) The director of enterprise services may set rates for persons participating in structured educational tours, group purchases, and promotional packages and persons with promotional coupons. The director of enterprise services is also authorized to allow entry of any person [~~in~~] to the Honolulu Zoo as part of a promotional offer or package made available by the city."

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to promote the development of affordable housing in the City and County of Honolulu. This ordinance does so by delaying the automatic repeal of Ordinance 19-8 (formerly Bill 7 (2019), CD2, FD1) and adding a date by which the Director of Planning and Permitting is directed to provide an updated report to the City Council with recommendations on whether the program established by Ordinance 19-8 should be repealed, modified, or extended. The new chapter ("Affordable Rental Housing") enacted by Ordinance 19-8, SECTION 2, has been codified as Chapter 32, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021 and is scheduled to "sunset" on May 21, 2024.

SECTION 2. SECTION 10 of Ordinance 19-8 is amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 10. This ordinance takes effect upon its approval and will be repealed ~~[five years after its effective date;]~~ seven years after the date on which Bill 8 (2023), or any amended version thereof, has been enacted into law and taken effect; provided that:

- (1) Any real property tax exemption authorized pursuant to Section ~~[8-10.X(b)(4)]~~ 8-10.33(b)(4) in SECTION 6 of this ordinance, and pursuant to Section ~~[8-10.Y(b)(4)]~~ 8-10.34(b)(4) in SECTION 7 of this ordinance, will apply to tax years beginning July 1, 2020; ~~[and]~~
- (2) The amendments made in SECTIONS 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 of this ordinance do not affect the repeal date of Ordinance 18-1~~[-];~~ and
- (3) No later than ~~[two years prior to the repeal date of this ordinance;]~~ May 21, 2022, the Director of Planning and Permitting shall submit to the City Council a report on the number of affordable rental housing units developed under this ordinance, and a recommendation regarding the repeal, modification, or extension of this ordinance."

SECTION 3. No later than one year after the effective date of this ordinance and by that date every year thereafter, the Director of Planning and Permitting shall submit to the City Council a report on the number of affordable housing units developed under Chapter 32, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021, as of that time.

No later than five years after the effective date of this ordinance, the Director of Planning and Permitting shall submit to the City Council a recommendation regarding the repeal, modification, or extension of Chapter 32, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021.

SECTION 4. In SECTION 2 of this ordinance, new ordinance material is underscored and ordinance material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken.


