SUBJECT: Statistics regarding Bill 28 (2023) - Relating to naloxone.


Thank you for the opportunity to share data on the administration of naloxone ("Narcan") by EMS personnel. The below chart indicates the number of doses of Narcan administered annually by EMS personnel. Please note that there is not enough specific data to report regarding overdose as a clinical impression.

The administration of Narcan is not limited to overdoses. Narcan can be administered for altered mental status or other cases where someone is not responding appropriately and the cause is unknown. The data does not support an increase in overdoses; however, the trend appears to be on an upswing, and the lethal effects of overdoses may be worse than in previous years. Regarding the public/private data, 2022 data showed that 53% of cases identified as overdoses occurred in a private setting, while 47% occurred in a public setting. Of those public cases, 97% of those did not appear to serve alcohol and only 1% (3) could be identified as some type of shelter.
