1. **RESOLUTION 23-220** – **REAPPOINTMENT OF VINCE OTSUKA TO THE BOARD OF REVIEW III FOR REAL PROPERTY TAX APPEALS.** Confirming the reappointment of Mr. Vince Otsuka to the Board of Review III for real property tax appeals for a term expiring June 30, 2028. (Transmitted by Communication MM-198; public hearing held 10/4/23)

PROPOSED CD1 TO RESOLUTION 23-220 (Submitted by Councilmember Cordero) – The CD1 (OCS2023-0928/10/11/2023 10:28 AM) makes the following amendments:

- A. In the first WHEREAS clause, updates the resolution to refer to the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021 instead of the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990 and notes that each real property tax board of appeals is composed of five members.
- B. Adds a new second WHEREAS clause stating that there are currently three real property tax boards of appeal.
- C. Transposes the former second and third WHEREAS clauses, and adds a reference to Charter Section 13-103 to the now fourth WHEREAS clause for clarity.
- D. In the now fifth WHEREAS clause, adds reference to "Mayor's Message 198 (2023)."
- E. Amends the BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED clause to add the Director of Budget and Fiscal Services as a recipient of the resolution.
- F. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.
- <u>RESOLUTION 23-250</u> TRANSFER OF FUNDS (DEM). Authorizing a transfer not to exceed \$262,500 in General Fund monies between the Provision for Grants, Partnerships and Security activity (current expenses) to DEM Emergency Management Coordination activity (current expenses) for fiscal year 2024 to complete a sustained pre-disaster natural hazard mitigation program with the understanding that \$200,000 will be reimbursed to the City. (Transmitted by Communication <u>D-709</u>)

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- RESOLUTION 23-251 TRANSFER OF FUNDS (DCS). Authorizing a transfer not to exceed \$458,038 in General Fund monies from the Provision for Grants, Partnerships and Security activity (current expenses) to the Department of Community Services, Community Based Development activity (salaries) for the fiscal year 2024 to meet the local match grant program needs of the DCS. (Transmitted by Communication <u>D-716</u>)
- 4. **RESOLUTION 23-240 LONG-TERM EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS.** Requesting the City Administration to present to the City Council budget recommendations that address long-term emergency preparedness no later than 150 days prior to the end of each fiscal year.
- <u>BILL 59 (2023)</u> RELATING TO INCENTIVES FOR FILM STUDIO FACILITIES. Providing incentives for eligible film studio facilities. (Bill passed first reading 10/4/23)
