ENGINEERING STUDY FOR REDUCTIONS OF MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS,"**

introduced on October 30, 2023, reports as follows:

The purpose of the resolution is to urge the Hawai'i State Legislature to enact legislation eliminating the requirement to conduct an engineering study for reductions of maximum speed limits on City streets, and to urge the City's Department of Transportation Services to assess lowering speed limits in City residential areas should the engineering study be eliminated.

The Director of Transportation Services testified in support of the measure.
