Mr. Chair:

Your Committee on Parks, Enterprise Services and Culture and the Arts, which considered Bill 63 (2023) entitled:

“A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 38, ARTICLES 3 AND 8, REVISED ORDINANCES OF HONOLULU 2021, AS AMENDED RELATING TO CONCESSIONS,”

transmitted by Departmental Communication 795 (23), dated November 14, 2023, by the Department of Enterprise Services, introduced on November 24, 2023, which passed first reading at the December 6, 2023 Council meeting, reports as follows:

The purpose of Bill 63 (2023) is to amend Section 38 of the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021 to: (1) address the repeal of the licensing requirements for beachboys in Hawaii Administrative Rules § 13-251, Subchapters 1, 2, 3, and 7, effective December 21, 2022; (2) transfer authority regarding nonprofit beachboy concessions to the department of enterprise services, as it is the department primarily responsible for the operation of such concessions; (3) further define the nonprofit status of beachboy associations to include tax exempt entities under § 501 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended; and (4) prescribe the location of the nonprofit beachboy concession.

Tracy Kubota, Deputy Director of Enterprise Services, testified in support of the measure.


