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THIS ADDENDUM PROVIDES A PROPOSED CD1 AMENDMENT TO AGENDA ITEM NO. 1 – RESOLUTION 24-65.

FOR ACTION

1. <u>RESOLUTION 24-65</u> – DENSITY ON RESIDENTIALLY ZONED LOTS AND COUNTY ZONING AUTHORITIES. Expressing the Honolulu City Council's strong concerns relating to House Bill 1630, H.D. 1, and Senate Bill 3202, S.D. 2, relating to urban development.

PROPOSED CD1 TO RESOLUTION 24-65 (Submitted by Council Chair Waters) – The CD1 (OCS 2024-0268/3/18/2024 2:40 PM) makes the following amendments:

A. Amends the seventh "WHEREAS" clause to read as follows:

"WHEREAS", allowing the subdivision of smaller zoning lots, even if requiring the resulting lots to be 2,000 square feet in size or greater as proposed in the State bills, may lead to a complex patchwork of small zoning lots within close proximity to each other," and

B. Makes miscellaneous technical and non-substantive amendments.
