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# THIS ADDENDUM PROVIDES A PROPOSED CD1 AMENDMENT TO AGENDA ITEM NO. 1 – BILL 23 (2024).

#### FOR ACTION

1. <u>BILL 23 (2024)</u> – **RELATING TO GIFTS.** Relating to gifts to City Officers and employees. (Bill passed First Reading on 4/17/24)

PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 23 (2024) Submitted by Councilmember Kiaʻāina) – The Proposed CD1 (OCS2024-0427/4/24/2024 11:03 AM) makes the following amendments:

#### A. In SECTION 2 of the bill:

1. Amends the definition of "Financial Relationship with the City" in ROH Section 1-19.7(a) by amending the second sentence of the definition to read as follows:

"The term includes lobbying, but does not include the employer and employee relationship of a city officer or employee with the city, nor does it include financial transactions with the city such as the receipt of a refund or rebate or a similar minimal contact with the city."

2. Amends ROH Section 1-19.7(c) to read as follows:

"A city officer or employee may not solicit, and, unless exempted by subsection (d), a city officer or employee may not accept or receive, either directly or indirectly through a third party, any gift if the city officer or employee knows or has reason to know that it is from a prohibited source. A city officer or employee is deemed to have reason to know that a gift is from a prohibited source if the gift is given, directly or indirectly, from any person who has appeared before the city officer or employee, or a body of which the city officer or employee is a member, in connection with the prohibited source's lobbying activities, financial relationship with the city, or both."

(Makes a conforming amendment in subsection (c) to reference "prohibited source's lobbying activities" rather than "person's lobbying activities.")

3. Amends ROH Section 1-19.7(d) to delete the requirement that the gifts falling within exemptions (1), (2), and (3) be "unsolicited," and to broaden the list of donors whose inter vivos or testamentary trust

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distributions are exempt from the prohibitions of ROH Section 1-19.7(c). The donors added to the list in ROH Section 1-19.7(d)(2) are the City officer's or employee's fiancé, fiancée, relative within four degrees of consanguinity, and the spouse, domestic partner, civil union partner, fiancé, or fiancée of such a relative. The donors added to the list in ROH Section 1-19.7(d)(3) are the ancestors of the City officer or employee.

B. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.
