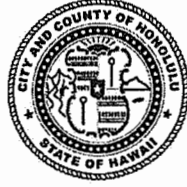

SUBJECT: Resolution 24-151 – Approving and Authorizing the Conveyance of the Former Kalaheo Elementary School Property in Kailua, O’ahu, to the State of Hawai’i, Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, in Furtherance of the Intent of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act and to Honor the Legacy of Prince Johnah Kūhiō Kalaniana’ole, Which Includes His Role in Establishing Hawai’i’s Counties, Including the City and County of Honolulu


The City has determined that the former Kalaheo Elementary School property, a 10.038 acre vacant parcel located on Iliaina Street in Kailua, O’ahu, zoned R-7.5 Residential District and P-1 Restricted Preservation District with a 2024 assessed value of \$10,455,000 and identified as Tax Map Key 4-4-033:018, has been determined to be surplus property (hereinafter referred to as “Kalaheo Hills Property”). Accordingly, on behalf of the Blangiardi Administration, with the concurrence of Corporation Counsel, I am recommending that the Kalaheo Hills Property, except for the portions of the property to be designated as roadways, be transferred by gift to the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands for purposes of providing native Hawaiians with homesteads.
