2. **BILL 44 (2024) – RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY.** Promoting public safety on roadways in the City and County of Honolulu by establishing more appropriate speed limits on certain streets. (Bill passed first reading 8/7/24)

PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 44 (2024) (Submitted by Councilmember Cordero) –
The CD1 (OCS2024-0870/9/20/2024 8:54 AM) makes the following amendments:

- A. In SECTION 2 of the bill, amends ROH Section 15-7.1 ("Speed restrictions") to include a provision:
 1. Authorizing the Director of Transportation Services to evaluate and implement the installation of traffic calming measures, including speed humps and raised crosswalks, in school zones; and
 2. Requiring the Director to notify the local community and school administrators of planned installations and solicit feedback to ensure the community needs and concerns are addressed.
- B. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.
