SUBJECT: Support for Bill 54 (2024) – Relating to the Creation
of the Taxable General Improvement Bond Fund


The Office of Housing (HOU) **supports** Bill 54 (2024), which would create the Taxable General Improvement Bond Fund to receive and expend proceeds from the sale of taxable bonds. This fund will be necessary to provide the flexibility needed to include mixed-use development as the City engages in the development of housing, as well as to provide a fiscal and budgetary control to separately track and account for taxable bond proceeds versus tax exempt bond proceeds.

Mixed-use development incorporates housing with other uses, such as childcare centers, commercial hubs, and governmental services. This type of development is part of the community vision laid out in the O'ahu General Plan, and is particularly desired in Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) areas. During the 2024 State Legislative Session, the City advocated for the counties to be able to use their bonds to provide the community with access to a range of services and opportunities close to where they live. This effort resulted in Act 45 (2024), which grants counties with the mixed-use development authority for a very limited period of time due to a 2028 sunset provision. In 2025, we will advocate for legislation to remove the Act's sunset provision. Mixed-use bond authority will help the City to redevelop and revitalize areas like Iwilei near the future Kuwili rail station.
