Your Committee on Budget, which considered Bill 60 (2024), CD1 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 43 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF HONOLULU 2021, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO SEWERS, DRAINAGE, AND CESSPOOLS,"

which passed second reading and was the subject of a public hearing at the April 16, 2025 Council meeting, reports as follows:

The purpose of the bill is to amend portions of Chapter 43, Revised Ordinance of Honolulu 2021 ("ROH"), as amended, by: (1) amending ROH Section 43-6.2 to include Accessory Dwelling Units in the "Residential" sewer service charge customer classification; (2) amending ROH Section 43-6.6 to remove all information related to nonresidential strength surcharges and replace it with information on wastewater disposal charges for waste haulers; (3) amending APPENDIX 43-A to include new sewer service charges, wastewater disposal charges, and to remove extra strength wastewater charges as well as a second customer category; (4) amending ROH Section 43-1 0.3 to include Accessory Dwelling Units; (5) amending ROH Section 43-10.4 to remove references to wastewater strength; and (6) amending Appendix 43-C to include new Wastewater System Facility Charges.

Your Committee approved a CD2 version that makes the following amendments:

A. In SECTION 5 of the bill, which amends ROH APPENDIX 43-A ("SEWER SERVICE CHARGE SCHEDULES"):

- (1) Amends the tables for Residential Sewer Service Charges, Nonresidential Sewer Service Charges, and Wastewater Disposal Charges to specify the amounts for these charges beginning January 1, 2026 and for fiscal years 2027 through 2032.
- (2) Adds new language at the end of the tables:
 - (a) To provide that, for fiscal year 2033 and every fiscal year thereafter, each of the sewer service charges in the appendix will increase by three percent annually, effective July 1 of each fiscal year;
 - (b) To establish a customer assistance program within the Department of Environmental Services to provide relief to certain households paying residential sewer charges; and
 - (c) To authorize the Director of Environmental Services or the Director's authorized representative to adopt rules pursuant to HRS Chapter 91 to implement and administer the customer assistance program.
- B. In SECTION 6 of the bill, separates accessory dwelling units ("ADUs") into its own category.
- C. In SECTION 8 of the bill, which amends ROH APPENDIX 43-C ("WASTEWATER SYSTEM FACILITY CHARGES"):
 - (1) Amends the tables for Residential Wastewater System Facility Charges, Low-income Housing Wastewater System Facility Charges, and Nonresidential Wastewater System Facility Charges for Domestic Strength Wastewater to specify the amounts for these charges beginning January 1, 2026 and for fiscal years 2027 through 2031; and

- (2) Adds new language at the end of the tables to provide that for fiscal year 2032 and every fiscal year thereafter, each of the charges in the appendix will increase by three percent annually, effective July 1 of each fiscal year.
- D. Adds a new SECTION 9 of the bill to repeal SECTIONS 99 through 102 of Ordinance 25-2. Renumbers subsequent SECTIONS of the bill.
- E. In renumbered SECTION 11 of the bill, changes the effective date to October 1, 2025; provided that SECTION 9 takes effect upon approval.
- F. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive changes.

Your Committee on Budget is in accord with the intent and purpose of Bill 60 (2024), CD1, as amended herein (Ayes: Dos Santos-Tam, Kiaʻāina, Weyer -3; Ayes with reservations: Cordero, Nishimoto -2; Noes: None), and recommends that it pass third reading in the form attached hereto as Bill 60 (2024), CD2. (Ayes: Dos Santos-Tam, Kiaʻāina, Weyer -3; Ayes with reservations: Nishimoto -1; Noes: Cordero -1.)

TO AMEND CHAPTER 43 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF HONOLULU 2021, RELATING TO SEWERS, DRAINAGE, AND CESSPOOLS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend portions of Chapter 43, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021 ("ROH"), by: (1) amending ROH Section 43-6.2 to include Accessory Dwelling Units in the "Residential" sewer service charge customer classification; (2) amending ROH Section 43-6.6 to remove all provisions related to nonresidential strength surcharges and replace it with provisions on wastewater disposal charges for waste haulers; (3) amending Appendix 43-A to include new sewer service charges and wastewater disposal charges, and to remove extra strength wastewater charges as well as a second customer category; (4) amending ROH Section 43-10.3 to include Accessory Dwelling Units; (5) amending ROH Section 43-10.4 to remove references to wastewater strength; and (6) amending Appendix 43-C to include new Wastewater System Facility Charges.

SECTION 2. Section 43-6.2, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021 ("Customer classifications"), is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

- "(a) "Residential" customers have been defined to include only the following:
 - (1) Single-family dwellings;
 - (2) Duplexes, apartment buildings, condominiums, and townhouses;
 - (3) Retirement hotels (permanent guests);
 - (4) Mobile homes and mobile home parks, if any; [er]
 - (5) Housing projects[-]; or
 - (6) Accessory dwelling units as defined in § 21-10.1."

SECTION 3. Section 43-6.6, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021, is repealed.

["§ 43-6.6 Nonresidential strength surcharges.

(a) In addition to user charges based solely on quantity, nonresidential users shall also be subject to a strength surcharge in accordance with § 43-1.8(i). A

monitoring program shall be initiated by the department to periodically measure the strength characteristics of wastewater discharges from these users, in accordance with § 43-1.8(k).

(b) — The nonresidential user charge schedule applies to domestic strength wastewater having an average suspended solids loading of 200 mg/L. The charge to a nonresidential user whose wastewater loading exceeds 200 mg/L shall be determined by means of the following formula, where SSm equals the measured suspended solids loading for that user and c is the user's charge per 1,000 gallons of either water usage or wastewater discharge, whichever applies.

Charge per 1000 gallons =
$$c \left[0.857 + \frac{0.143 (SSm)}{200} \right]$$

- (c) All nonresidential users that discharge wastewater having suspended solids loadings greater than 200 mg/L shall be identified by the department and shall be subject to this strength surcharge, effective upon the completion of construction of Phase II, Sand Island sewage treatment plant.
- (d) Strength surcharges for BOD₅-shall not be levied against nonresidential users until completion of the west and east Mamala Bay secondary treatment facilities, as applicable.
- (e) The actual formulas for water usage and wastewater discharge are shown in the sewer service charge schedules listed separately in Appendix 43-A."]

SECTION 4. Chapter 43, Article 6, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021 ("Sewer Service Charges"), is amended by adding a new Section 43-6.6 to read as follows:

"§ 43-6.6 Wastewater disposal charges for waste haulers.

Waste haulers transporting wastewater to a city facility for wastewater disposal are subject to the wastewater disposal charges listed in Appendix 43-A."

SECTION 5. Chapter 43, Article 6, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021 ("Sewer Service Charges"), is amended by amending Appendix 43-A to read as follows:

"APPENDIX 43-A: SEWER SERVICE CHARGE SCHEDULES

[The] These charges [in column 1] apply to all customers[,except those customers for which a sewer service contract/agreement exists between the customer and the City and County of Honolulu that provides that column 2 charges shall apply. Sewer service contracts/agreements that allow column 2 charges are intended for customers who have paid their share of capital costs of collection, treatment and disposal of their wastewater by the city.] as specified in the following schedules.

Customer assistance program. A customer assistance program is hereby established within the department to provide relief to certain households paying residential sewer charges. The director may adopt rules pursuant to HRS Chapter 91 to implement and administer the customer assistance program."

SECTION 6. Section 43-10.3, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021 ("Residential wastewater system facility charges"), is amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

"(b) The following weights [shall be] <u>are</u> assigned to the various categories of residential developments for wastewater system facility charge purposes:

SECTION 7. Section 43-10.4, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021, is amended to read as follows:

"§ 43-10.4 Nonresidential wastewater system facility charges.

(a) Each applicant for a nonresidential building permit for a new structure, or for an enlargement of an existing structure, or for an increase in the wastewater system entitlement shall be required to pay a wastewater system facility charge based on the imputed number of equivalent single-family dwelling units in the project to be constructed[¬]; provided that the director shall reduce the amount of the facility charge upon consideration of the applicant's financial contribution for backup facilities constructed or to be constructed for the project and dedicated or to be dedicated to the city.

This requirement applies to those new applicants for service and to those existing structures that are subject to liability under § 43-10.1.

(b) The new applicant for service, or an owner wishing to increase the owner's wastewater system capacity entitlement, shall be required to obtain from the board of water supply, or from the State department of land and natural resources in the case of private water wells, the size of the water meter to be provided for the project to be constructed. The number of ESDUs [shall-be] is determined from the following table based on the water meter size:

- The applicable wastewater system facility charge per ESDU [for domestic strength wastewater] is set forth in Appendix 43-C of this chapter.
- [(d) With respect to wastewater strength, a reasonable estimate of the suspended solids loading shall be consistent with the estimates used by the department for strength surcharge purposes, in accordance with § 43-6.6.
- (e) The applicable wastewater system facility charge for extra strength wastewater shall be based on the following formula:

Wastewater System Facility Charge for extra strength wastewater = A + ((SSi/200) x B)
where SSi = the imputed suspended solids loading, in mg/L

The applicable values for terms "A" and "B" in the above formula are set forth in Appendix 43-C of this chapter.]

[(f)](d) All nonresidential applicants who are liable for payment under this article may install a sub-water meter to monitor their sewage discharge."

SECTION 8. Chapter 43, Article 6, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021 ("Sewer Service Charges"), is amended by amending Appendix 43-C to read as follows:

For fiscal year 2032 and every fiscal year thereafter, each of the wastewater system facility charges in this appendix will increase by 3 percent annually, effective July 1 of each fiscal year."

SECTION 9. SECTIONS 99 through 102 of Ordinance 25-2 are repealed.

Description:

Amends various sections and appendices of ROH Chapter 43 to include Accessory Dwelling Units as a sewer customer classification; update sewer service charges and wastewater system facility charges, including an automatic 3 percent annual increase beginning fiscal year 2033 for sewer service charges and fiscal year 2032 for wastewater system facility charges; add wastewater disposal charges for sewer customers; remove references to extra strength wastewater; establish a customer assistance program within the ENV to provide relief to households paying residential sewer charges; and to allow the ENV Director or the Director's authorized representative to adopt rules to implement and administer the customer assistance program. The revised charges commence on January 1, 2026 and the repeal of certain provisions in Ordinance 25-2 takes effect upon approval.
