5. **BILL 73 (2025) – RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.** Amending certain provisions relating to traffic and vehicles. (Bill passed first reading 11/5/25; Committee postponed action 11/19/25)

**PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 73 (2025)** (Submitted by Councilmember Dos Santos-Tam) – The CD1 (OCS2026-0117/2/25/2026 4:41 PM) makes the following amendments:

- A. Adds a new SECTION 12 to repeal ROH § 15-15.6, relating to credit of annual fees. Renumbers subsequent sections.
  
- B. Adds a new SECTION 16 to repeal ROH § 15-20.2, related to inspection fees.

- C. Adds a new SECTION 17 to amend ROH § 15-23.2B by increasing the charge of unclaimed vehicles from \$1 to \$10.
- D. Adds a new SECTION 22 to amend ROH § 15A-3.1 by clarifying the vehicle weight tax rate and repealing the minimum vehicle weight tax.
- E. Adds a new SECTION 23 to amend ROH § 15A-3.2 by increasing the delinquent penalties for vehicles taxed at the passenger rate from \$8 to \$20, and vehicles taxed at the commercial rates from \$20 to \$50.
- F. Adds a new SECTION 24 to insert a severability clause.
- G. Renumbers SECTIONS as necessary to accommodate new SECTIONS added.
- H. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.
