Your Committee on Budget, which considered Bill 87 (2020) entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PUBLIC TRANSIT,"

transmitted by Departmental Communication 707 (2020), dated October 23, 2020, from the Department of Transportation Services, and which passed First Reading at the November 5, 2020 Council meeting, reports as follows:

The purpose of the bill is to amend Chapter 13, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, to amend the fare for paratransit services.

At your Committee's meeting on November 24, 2020, your Committee considered Bill 87 (2020) and Bill 89 (2020) together.

The Acting Director of Transportation Services testified and provided comments on the bill.

Your Committee received remote and written testimony in support of the bill from the Honolulu Rate Commission and the Disability and Communication Access Board. Remote and written comments were received from the Citizens for a Fair Americans with Disability Act Ride. Written comments were received from one individual.
