I am in strong support for Res. 21-34, which urges increased flexibility for electronic participation in and public access to meetings of City and County of Honolulu boards and commissions, City Council, and other City agencies to increase and assure effective citizen participation in local government.

COVID-19 restrictions have definitely limited the way citizens participate in meetings. Those who do not have internet connection and computers or smart phone are not able to participate in presenting their concerns orally. Those that do have the equipment are still sometimes thwarted by glitches with Webex.

The practice of having all testimonies at the beginning of the session seems disjointed, especially if there are many items on the agenda that a person wishes to testify about. By the time the Chair gets to the items on the agenda, the related testimonies are sometimes lost in the discussion or vote. It would be better if there was a more user friendly approach to have the testimonies conducted while a measure is being discussed.

Is there another virtual meeting program that would allow this to take place? For example Zoom allows for chat that can be controlled by the meeting administrator.

Could the Council and Neighborhood boards also consider creating meeting hubs on City or State properties where those without computer access could go (with appropriate social distancing and masking) to participate in the discussions?

Please pass this resolution to encourage efforts to increase better participation of the public in issues that are important to a better community.
